LaVoy: Dead Man Talking

LaVoy - Dead Man Talking is the 4 episode docu-series about LaVoy Finicum, the rancher killed by Oregon State and Federal Law enforcement on January 26, 2016.

“Little did LaVoy Finicum know that his journey would carry him from the 2014 Bundy Standoff to the 2016 Oregon occupation of the Malheur Wildlife Refuge, as a media-labeled domestic extremist, deemed a domestic terrorist threat, and eventually shot in the back by the Governing.”



In Episode 1, LaVoy explains to you, in his own words, why he stood up to what he felt was a 'government bully' and describes, in detail, each and every decision he makes along the way.

All proceeds will be shared equally between Jeanette Finicum and Center for Self Governance. Jeanette will use the proceeds for her 'wrongful death' legal fund, and CSG will use the proceeds to advance applied civics across the country.

The Final Verdict: Oregon & Nevada Trials

Those who remained alive, from the Oregon and Nevada events, found themselves imprisoned for two years without bail, redress of grievance, or defense in a court of law. Each of their stories and ending deserve their own documentary!

FOUNDATIONAL CIVICS TRAINING

Class is 4 hours; Tuition is \$50/person; Workbook is included; \$40/17 & under/class; No Prerequisites

Introduction to Government Structures

You will learn basic Government Structures, understand concepts of Power, System, and Control, and identify jurisdictional boundaries and controls.

STATE CONSTITUTION STUDY PROGRAM

You will analyze the Systematic Politics of Marble Cake Federalism, study Partisan Political cycles, its influence on the Governed's decision-making & behavior, and develop Systematic Political strategies to compete with Marble Cake Federalism.
