RE: Affidavit of Concern to be shared with the Select Subcommittee on the Weaponization of the Federal Government

**To Whom It May Concern:**

Our federal non-profit is listed as ‘anti-government’ by another non-government organization (SPLC – Southern Poverty Law Center) on its public website. We honor their free speech rights. However, SPLC publicly states that it informs, educates, and trains law enforcement, the media, and the public about ‘extremist’ organizations, as part of its ‘Hate Watch’ mission.

**We have three (3) concerns:**

1. A non-government organization is utilizing both witting and unwitting Law enforcement as a weapon against its perceived political opponents.
2. A non-government organization is using media to perpetuate misinformation about perceived threats posed by its political opponents.
3. A non-government organization is exploiting the public’s fear and inciting them to violence against its political opponents.

**We have multiple solutions with action:**

1. Discover whether the SPLC, or any other NGO, is, or has ever, been consulted by airlines regarding the NO FLY LIST
2. Discover whether any Federal Department, Bureau, or Agency has used SPLC, or any other NGO, for education and training as part of its EXTREMISM, HATE, ANTI-GOVERNMENT efforts.
3. Create legal definitions for EXTREMISM, ANTI-GOVERNMENT, and ENEMY
4. Create legal distinctions between DOMESTIC VIOLENT EXTREMIST and DOMESTIC TERRORIST
5. Create Federal restrictions for NGO list usage
6. Clarify legal intention as to which U.S. citizens the a DOMESTIC TERRORISM label applies to
7. Clarify the legal distinction between a NGO Extremism List and Federal Extremism List
8. Prohibit the use or creation of a Federal Domestic Terrorist or Federal Domestic Violent Extremist List that does not have a connection to a Foreign Terrorist Organization (Designated by the Department of State).
9. If a Federal List is created, develop clearly defined and public due process standards (1) for U.S. citizens, (2) for informing individuals or groups labeled and listed, and (3) for the labeled and listed to seek remedy and removal from such a Federal List
10. Reduce Liability Protections for NGO’s creating a LIST that is both public and/or used by Law Enforcement
